#### One if by Land

In 1915, Swiss art historian Heinrich Wölfflin pointed out in his book *Principles of Art History* that "There is no art form and style that can suit all ages. The formation of the artworks and their styles and forms is not only related to the artist's personality, but also related to the spirit of the time period". The social function of art has evolved throughout the overall art history. From custom painting to the art of today's consumerism era, as the creation aesthetics for the sole purpose of survival has gradually become marginalized, the social function of art spawned more possibilities. The art market development shows that artists' personal expressions are becoming increasingly more important. In fact, artists constantly absorb their audience's desire to create so



that the two now can communicate and interact. Art exhibitions are not only unilateral; output is a two-way spiritual exchange. Therefore, regarding artworks as a link, artists and their viewers has begun to form an evolving relationship.

Reflexive group exhibition *One if by Land* will be held from July 19th to October 7th, 2019 at Hall 6 in Powerlong Museum in Shanghai. Curated by Rongsi Gao and co-organized by Powerlong Museum and Siart(BJ) Culture Communication Co., Ltd., the exhibition is honored to gather 25 works of 15 international outstanding artists of different backgrounds to explore contemporary art by presenting various interpretations of the concept of "modernity", discovering how the relationship between artist, artwork and audience develops.
